more OPEC countries are willing to trade oil for stable currencies. As the nations of the world find that they do not require US paper-dollars, more OPEC countries will abandon the US dollar. The worst case scenario is that the US will eventually have to by oil with Euros, or, Rubles instead of just printing money. The world economy will be very different at the end of this century.

SHARIA LAW.....

The UK is becoming embroiled in the must win debate on whether Sharia law should become part of the British legal system. At this time, the overwhelming majority of British people do not agree with this move. The politicians are typically non committal and are being seen to be less than protective of the British heritage of centuries.

France has declared the wearing of the burqha in public is now illegal, and the Swiss are about to vote, polls showing 99.99% against any move to Islamic values in that country.

Under Sharia law, women have no status whatsoever. A muslim man is able to marry a baby as young as 12 months, and should consummate that marriage before the child reaches 9 years of age. Education of females is not allowed. Women take no part in the decisions for the household. Women are not able to have legal representation and are sentenced to payback rape. stoning to death, whipping and beheading at the whim of a selected town leader. A muslim woman cannot obtain a divorce and may be killed by her family if the honour of the family is

thought to have been damaged. A muslim man is allowed 4 wives and unlimited "temporary wives" for up to an hour if he desires. Islamic scholars agree that those who criticise, or leave the Islamic faith, should be executed. It is now becoming alarmingly apparent that it is conceivable the USA, and some Western European countries could have a Islamic President in about 20 years because of the population imbalances. Examples exist already in the USA. Dearborn in Michigan is one of several towns taken over.
