AUSTRALIAN CONVICT HERITAGE

Approximately 169,000

people were transported to the new colonies under terrible conditions, by sea. The youngest was 9 years old and the oldest was 82! The average age was 26 and 80% had been convicted of larceny. Females made up 20% of the entire lot. The first female convict was Elizabeth Thackery, she was sentenced to 75 years for stealing 5 hankies! William Smith O'Brien, an Irish revolutionary was transported for leading a uprising in Tipperary.

Red Kelly, father of Ned, was amongst the first ships. Margaret Dawson, a First Fleet convict became known as "The Founding Mother" of Australia.



LOST ANOTHER ONE

Heinz is a US conglomerate that has shut down the tomato sauce manufacturing site at Girgarre in Victoria. It was closed as of Friday, 6th January 2012 and has sacked 150 workers, citing product supply and costs as the reasons. The plant is up for sale but there is a rider to this. Dick Smith Foods wants to buy the plant as a going concern to restart making genuine Australian tomato (content) sauce there.

The Yanks are baulking at this......

Why? Because the genuine Australian contents will then be in direct competition to the New Zealand based product !!! How many times do you buy tomato sauce? 3 or 4 times a year probably.
