55TH ANNIVERSARY

SITREP: The planned 55th anniversary commemoration for the CEASE FIRE of the Indonesian Confrontation war in Kuching, Sarawak, on 28th August 2021, has been cancelled, due entirely to the COVID-19 pandemic..

"**Plan B**" is now being arranged and the ideas at this point are twofold; at the Australian War Memorial in Canberra on 11 August and in Adelaide on 27th or, 28th August.

This significant Australian military anniversary will be open to all surviving veterans from the Australian, New Zealand, Malaysian and UK armed forces together with their families and friends in both locations.

Plans will include suggestions for accommodation and the services to be conducted at each proposed site. At this time, the COVID-19 disruptions within the Australian state borders are indicating a much better scenario will / may be in operation....we can only hope so.

The service on 11 August at the AWM will be dedicated to the 55th Anniversary....

SA & NT BRANCH MEETINGS

VACCINATIONS

The first 80,000 Astra Zeneca vials were delivered by air into Sydney on 15 Feb and the priority roll out for injections will commence from Monday, 22 February.

The logistics to be tested for the national coverage may be adjusted as the roll out increases with the availability increasing from imports and the new purpose built Australian laboratory comes on line.

Two vaccinations are necessary and the interval between the injections is two weeks.

56 million injections plus spares in total...
