WELCOME BACK FOR 2019.

The New Year has started with a extraordinary burst of heatwave conditions in the southern half of the Australian States during January for which we were given a prelude prior to Christmas.....records were broken which were set going back to 1939 and the Iron Triangle cities of Whyalla, Port Augusta and Port Pirie were baked for 5 consecutive days of 40 C–49 C. Adelaide's new record temperature is 46.8 C.....the temperature recorded on the main runway at Adelaide Airport went to 75.3 C....

Bushfires were horrific in WA, NSW and in Tasmania. North Queensland is underwater again and the only redeeming feature about that is the flow on will help to flush the Murray Darling River System which is almost at a stand still on the SA side of the NSW / VIC border.....as a result of public outcries, the Murray–Darling Basin Commission has been sacked and a investigation has confirmed the very obvious self interest of the former members, particularly those with cotton and rice farming interests....the water flow into the Murray has been redirected, in some upper NSW areas completely blocked, which caused Medindie Lakes to dry up and Broken Hill city to be placed into a position of having to truck in water.....The Murray Darling Basin Management Committee has been sacked....criminal charges must be considered and a full, open to the public investigation commenced post haste.....including interrogation of the National Party member, Barnaby Joyce MP who was the Minister responsible.....

Association presents aid to three schools

KUCHING: The Malaya Borneo Veterans Association (MBVA) presented aid to three schools in Bau yesterday.

The contribution is to help SK Suba Buau, SK Stass, and SK Serabak co-organiser activities.

Sarawak Tourism Federation (STF) Heritage Development Committee chairman Datuk Lim Kian Hock said the three schools were adopted by the association during its 50th anniversary reunion here in 2016.

The association comprises Australian veterans deployed to Sarawak during the Indonesian confrontation between 1964 and 1965, who were stationed at the border areas of Lundu and Bau.

A letter from MBVA president Brian Selby stated that the donations were raised by members from the South Australian and Northern Territory Branch, as well as from Ting.


"We have very fond memories of our visit to each school in

SITREP

Beds are now open

The first two steps of the 6 step plans to bring the Daws Rd Repatriation General Hospital back to a fully functioning hospital have been completed and Step 3 is now the evaluations after all the submissions have been coordinated, from SA NT Branch, VVA, WF and RSL SA.

As promised, the redevelopment of the site is very well placed in the order of priorities and a unexpected benefit will be the ability to take the strain off the newly opened Jamie Larkin Centre at Glenside which has now reached capacity; waiting times have blown out to 6 weeks plus if a veteran needs 24/7 mental health care initially.....

as we have previously stated, the closure of The Repat was a very poor decision by the previous Labor govt and has added to the delays at the Flinders Medical Centre...and elsewhere.

As we had co-proposed, the Heart, Eye, Urology and the Out Patient clinics plus 20 beds will be reopened and updated as very important parts of the REACTIVATION of THE REPAT... *banyak bagusla.....*




