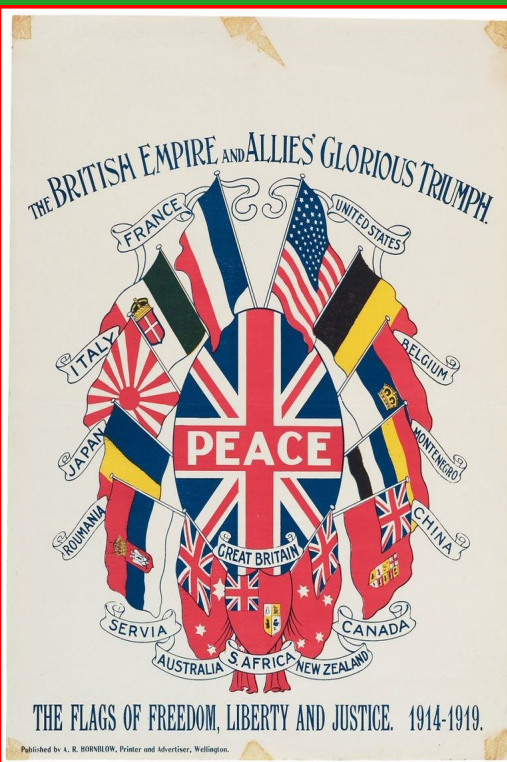

The Treaty of Versailles was signed for Australia on 28 June, 1919, in the great Hall of Mirrors by the Prime Minister, Billy Hughes and the Deputy PM, Mr Cook. 31 nations signed the document which has 15 Parts and 440 Articles. It includes restoration payments to be strictly enforced for at least 5 years.

The Treaty was invalidated when Adolf Hitler came to power in 1935.

11 September 2020 will commemorate the 75th Anniversary of the end of WW2 in the Pacific.

Brigadier Tom Eastick CMG DSO ED, 9 DIV AIF, KUCHING DET, took the Japanese surrender near Kuching at Batu Lintang, Sarawak, which was a Allied POW camp.

In addition, some sections of the proposed Sarawak Defenders Memorial Trail may be dedicated to the Australian Army casualties and those engaged in the defence of Sarawak from June 1962–August 1966.

THE MALAYAN WARS

Post WW2 there have been two undeclared wars fought on the Malayan Peninsula, in Sabah and in Sarawak. From 1948–1960, the Malayan Emergency and from 1962–1966 the Indonesian Confrontation. Australian Armed Forces were engaged in both.

There are still no dedicated and proper public Memorials to honour the men who did not come home, to the men who were injured and to the men and women who served.

These two undeclared wars are the only two in which Australia was engaged that do not have a place of Honour for the families and friends of the Australian service personnel to visit and show their respects. It is now over 59 years and 53 years respectively since the Cease Fire for both wars. Why were these military campaigns not declared as wars?

Because the vested interests in the rubber plantations and the tin mines would not have been able to claim compensation for damages caused to these sites if they had been caused by acts of war.....Brigadier Alf Garland AM wrote a epitaph to the Indonesian Confrontation....

"No one knew we went up there. No one knew we fought there. Now, no one cares. It's a disgrace".....kami jangan lupakan.....

SARAWAK MEMORIALS

In August 2014, a group of veterans from South Australia visited Kuching Sarawak to try and locate some of the sites where the Australian units had been based adjacent to the Kalimantan–Sarawak border, and attempt to find some surviving Iban Trackers who had been their guides during the Confrontation war. This visit resulted in an invitation being given to place a Memorial in the *Heroe's Graveyard* at Jalan Taman Budaya for the Australian casualties. The Memorial was unveiled and dedicated on 29 August, 2016, and is next to the SASR Memorial.....

In August, 2019, veterans from the NMBVAA, SASR, AAFC and RAN conducted a joint commemoration service at Jalan Taman Budaya with New Zealand Malaya Veterans' Association veterans, Malaysian veterans and representatives from the UK NMBVA and RAF veterans.

The High Commissioners and the Defence Advisers from Australia and New Zealand and the Defence Adviser from the UK, 150 Malaysian veterans and serving soldiers attended. The Very Reverend Koh, Dean of Kuching officiated. After the service lunch was held in the Sarawak Club.....*banyak bagusla...*

SARAWAK 2019

The idea for a "Memorial Trail" to be built to include the strong points and bases where the Australian battalions and SASR patrolled and Australian artillery provided supporting fire along the Kalimantan border with Sarawak is now a reality. Initial surveying and location work has been done; a start point will be sited in Kuching and move to Kampung Gumbang and Kampung Stass via Bau, Suba Buan, Serikin, Krokong, Bukit Knuckle, Bunan Mawang now Bunan Gega, Kampung Gunan Gajah and others, and if accessible, several SASR Insert and Extract Grid References.

The "Sarawak Defender's Trail" will not be suitable for walking due to the distances and the terrain between most sites and distance between the Start point and the Finish point. It will be more suited to a off road type of vehicle.

Each site will be properly signposted and where practical, viewing platforms will be built to overlook the sites....finished in time for the 55th Cease Fire anniversary in August 2021...

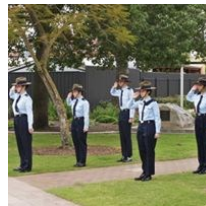
