50TH ANNIVERSARY TOUR

August 2016 will mark the 50th Anniversary of the Cease Fire and Declaration of the End of the Indonesian Confrontation with Malaysia. A specific commemoration tour to Sarawak is being planned, and the attached notices are where we are currently at. The scope of the plans has changed and the notices will now include the New Zealand MVA members.

The original idea was simply for any interested former Australian members who served in the prescribed Areas of Operations to consider making the tour. At this time, the word has apparently been passed to some units in the UK, including the Royal Marines, the Parachute Regiment and the Royal Navy river patrol units. The anniversary is not on the radar of DVA, the RSL, or, particular ESO's....

There is a request for 5 x national flags to be donated by the Minister, however, there is no funding available to assist with the manufacture of the black granite Memorial to be unveiled on 29 August, 2016, in the Sarawak War Memorial Gardens. Our Memorial will be similar to the SAS Memorial being unveiled on 8 August 2015, at the same location....

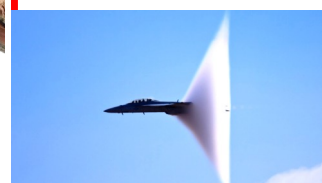
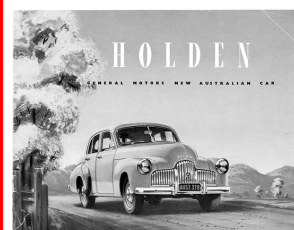

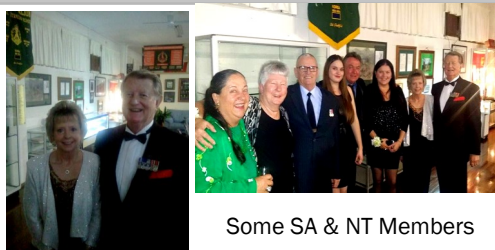

Guest Speaker was COL Rob Manton, the Director of Veterans' SA.

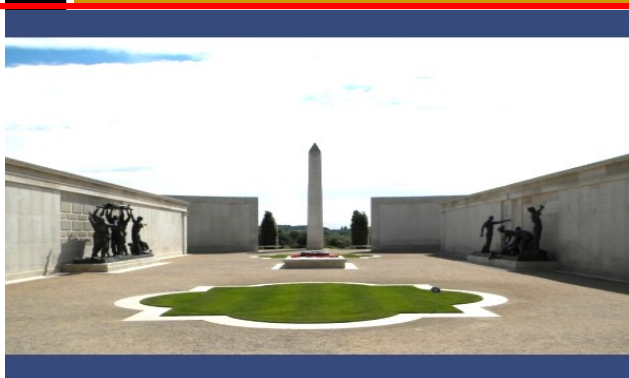
A three course dinner with selected red and white wines was served and the traditional toasts were confirmed with Dinner Port. Personally named and laminated place mats were gifted to all.
